Notes to Prospective bidders

Bidders are required to submit the following as part of their tender documents:

- A valid original TAX clearance certificate,
- A CIDB Certificate must be attached
- A certified copy of company registration certificate with CIPRO,
- A proposed work programme for the construction
- A BEE certificate
- The Ingquza Hill local Municipality Supply Chain Management policy will apply.

Please note that companies who do not submit their BEE certificates will not be disqualified but they will not score on the BEE status level points.

The preferential point system that will be used will be 80/20
